

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

WHY? Part 1 External Stakeholders Need This Information

Many Jurisdictions Point to PT Compact Website



If you did not find a licensee please also check the PT Compact Commission verification page ****** to see if the PT or PTA holds a compact privilege in Nebraska.


PT Compact Privilege Verification - The Physical Therapy Compact Commission provides online primary source verification of Compact Privileges.

Challenges with pointing to PT Compact Website

- The language on the jurisdiction's website to go look at PT Compact Website is often not on the same page as the licensure verification
 - External stakeholders verifying authorization to practice may never read that information (and most likely never will)





WHY? Part 2 State Mandate


- State system is a way for most healthcare workers (and other licenses) to be verified on one site
 - May include:
 - Licensees
 - Compact Privilege Holders
 - Temporary Licensees (if applicable)
 - Telehealth Registry (if applicable)
 - Military licenses (if applicable)
 - Etc.
 - State Medicaid program uses this data to determine provider eligibility via a daily connection to the Medicaid billing system
 - Credentialers for insurers also use

WHY? Part 2 Transparency

- The public does not know the difference between a license and a compact privilege
- They definitely do not know whether their healthcare practitioner holds a license or a compact privilege for purposes of look-up
- This data is one of the most important pieces of a Board's duty to fulfill the mission of public protection

How are you doing this?


- Manual Entry by Staff
 - Human error
 - Required extra work/ and rechecking for errors
- Not timely
 - o Entry was made weekly
 - Did not meet the same standard as licenses

How can we do it better?

- How can we automate?
- Improved Accuracy?
- Timeliness?

- ANSWER: Application Programming Interface (API)
 - FSBPT ID
 - NPTE Scores
 - JAM Scores now associated with compact record in the system
 - PT Compact Privilege Information





Louisiana's Experience

- Independent Board Website
- "See PT Compact Verification Website"
- Board wanted a "One-stop shop"
- Administratively unrealistic to manually enter this in a timely and accurate way.
- API was the best solution.


